All concerns / PIPFA Centre In-charges are hereby reminded to **strictly** follow the PIPFA policies being issued through career plan, notifications and official communications from time to time. Some policies are hereunder for ready reference and implementation:

- No exemption shall be granted in CCPT to any student on basis of qualification of any degree, paper and/or certificate courses, what so ever.
- All concerns / PIPFA Centre In-charges are advised to instruct their Final Level students to join the classes for CCPT to produce their certificates well before declaration of Results.
- The students who have passed all PIPFA Examinations through Corporate Sector and now have joined PIPFA as an AGP trainee shall get exemption in the course of Performance Measurement.
- The students who have qualified B.Com (HONS) of 4 years shall be given exemptions in 6 papers mentioned in Career Plan of PIPFA.
- Exemptions are granted on the basis of complete qualification.
- Exemptions are available subject to 80% course coverage of a respective subject.
- Exemptions are available for HEC recognized universities and institutes only.
- The exemptions will be granted to those students only who have gotten at least 60% marks in the subject in which exemption is applied for, except B.Com level candidates. The cases of "Failure Condoned" in the subject in which exemption is applied for will not be entertained at any case.
- The exemptions from any subject of PIPFA syllabus are available only on studying and passing the corresponding course in the qualification on the basis of which exemption is being claimed.
- The students who have applied for exemption (Except B.Com. students) will have to submit detailed course contents(duly attested) from their respective

university/institute for evaluation purpose failing which their exemption can not be acceded to.

- The students who claim for exemptions are required to submit attested copies of marks sheets of Part – I & II and of Part – III in case of B.Com. (Hons) or consolidated transcript alongwith the exemption form, failing which their case of exemption will not processed.
